


From the Pastor's Pen / De la Pluma del Padre

We are in the middle of summer break. Many people have taken trips or gone on vacation. In 2006, Pope Benedict gave a reflection on the purpose of vacation and rest which has always resonated with me. One purpose of vacation and rest is "to strengthen [our] mind and body, which, given the hectic course of modern existence, daily undergoes a continuous fatigue and strain." But more than that, vacation is also "a precious opportunity to spend more time with relatives, to visit family and friends" and to renew our connection with them. Vacation is also a time for God. Pope Benedict states succinctly, "Having more free time, one can dedicate oneself more easily to conversation with God, meditation on Sacred Scripture and reading some useful, formative book." May we make good use of this time! Finally, it is important not to neglect those who are in need during the summer, especially, "the elderly and the sick who often experience solitude even more during this time". We have more time for friends, we have more time for God, and we have more time to reach out to the lonely. May God bless our vacation time.

Es decir, es oportunidad de renovar nuestro contacto con ellos. El papa explica suavemente, <<Al disponer de más tiempo libre, nos podemos dedicar con mayor facilidad a hablar con Dios, a meditar en la sagrada Escritura y a leer algún libro útil y formativo.>>. Que aprovechemos este tiempo! Por fin, el papa dice que es importante no olvidarse de los necesitados, <<en particular, en quienes viven solos, en los ancianos y en los enfermos, los cuales a menudo, en este período, sufren aún más la soledad.>>. Tenemos mas tiempo para amigos, tenemos mas tiempo para Dios, y tenemos mas tiempo para extender la mano los aislados. Que Dios bendiga este tiempo de vacación.

RIGHT RELATIONSHIPS

Our God is about relationships. In the first reading, Moses reminds the Israelites that the laws, which are already in their hearts, keep them in right relationship with the God who loves them so much that they always find forgiveness. Centuries later, along comes Jesus, whom Paul describes to the Colossians as “the image of the invisible God,” the very embodiment of this God of love. In his parable about the good Samaritan, Jesus explains how the law of love overrules the letter of the law. Instead of answering the question “Who is my neighbor?” Jesus demonstrates that it is not about who is worthy of being loved, but rather loving as God loves—about *being* neighbor, about being the good Samaritan. Jesus wants us to continue his work as images of this God of love by loving *all* people, even those who seem to be our enemies.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading — Heed the voice of the LORD. It is something very near to you, already in your hearts; you only need to carry it out (Deuteronomy 30:10-14).

Second Reading — All things were created through and for Christ Jesus (Colossians 1:15-20).

Gospel — To be a neighbor, show love by treating others with mercy, as did the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37).

RELACIONES CORRECTAS

Nuestro Dios es acerca de relaciones. En la primera lectura, Moisés les recuerda a los israelitas que las leyes, que ya están en sus corazones, los mantiene en una relación correcta con el Dios que los ama tanto que siempre consiguen el perdón. Siglos después, llega Jesús, a quien Pablo describe a los colosenses como “la imagen del Dios invisible”, la encarnación misma de este Dios de amor. En su parábola acerca del buen samaritano, Jesús explica cómo la ley de amor anula la letra de la ley. En lugar de responder a la pregunta “¿quién es mi prójimo?” Jesús demuestra que no se trata de quien es digno de ser amado, sino de amar como Dios ama, de ser prójimo, de ser el buen samaritano. Jesús quiere que continuemos su obra como imágenes de este Dios de amor, amando a todas las personas, incluso a las que parecen ser nuestros enemigos.


